Your application for a UK visa has been successful. This means that when you arrive in the UK you will have permission to be in the UK (known as Leave to Enter) as STUDENT from dd mmm yyyy to dd mmm yyyy.

What this means for you

Your passport/travel document contains a vignette (visa sticker), which you will use to travel to the UK. The vignette is valid for 30 days. If you do not arrive in the UK within this 30 day period you will need to apply for a vignet trans to, the test provided trans to the tra

What you must do after an val UK

You must collect your BRP from the following collection point before your vignette expires or within 10 days of arriving in the UK, whichever is the later. If you fail to do so, you may be subject to a financial penalty or a reduction or cancellation of your leave.

If you leave the UK before you collect your BRP you may experience delays at the border upon your return, while further checks are made.
